**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO ENLARGE ORAL ARGUMENT TIME
TO TWENTY MINUTES PER SIDE**

Defendants-appellees, the Federal Housing Finance Agency (“FHFA”) and the Department of the Treasury, respectfully move to extend the oral argument time in this case to 20 minutes for each side. The FHFA and Treasury, which have been sued separately and have filed separate briefs, would each present argument for ten minutes. Plaintiff-appellant has stated that it does not oppose this motion.

This case raises a number of distinct challenges to actions taken by Treasury and FHFA with respect to agreements between Treasury and FHFA related to the conservatorships of the Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae) and the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (Freddie Mac). Plaintiff presents a number of distinct arguments, some of which pertain only to Treasury or only to FHFA. Treasury and FHFA filed separate briefs, and all the parties filed briefs at or

near the word limit. Twenty minutes of oral argument will provide this Court with adequate time to hear argument on the issues presented in the case.
